Improving the Podiatry Workflow

The growing patient population is placing greater strain on the typical linear design of in-office procedure environments that utilize shared corridors and publicly exposed workstations.

Hallways are often crowded with equipment, patients and caregivers—this can cause privacy issues and impact the overall patient experience.

The COVID-19 pandemic has served as a reminder that this traditional design can also threaten infection prevention efforts. For instance, crowded

hallways make it difficult to socially distance, movement throughout the facility increases potential for exposure, and open procedure and waiting rooms can be a focal point for transmission.

Patient-centered workflow designs allow podiatrists to better manage and limit patient interac-

tions and movement throughout the facility and can reduce the potential for exposure to contagions or transmission of pathogens. Examples include the continuous care model that centralizes and consolidates the patient visit as much as possible, the self-rooming model that eliminates the waiting room, and the dual access model that provides separate, dedicated corridors for caregivers and patients.

New Findings from Mod Med Patient Survey

Patients will seek out a new doctor that will make a better fit with factors such as timeliness, friendliness of the staff, and use of modern technology contributing to the overall experience, according to a new survey from





practice technology leader ModMed and conducted by independent research firm OnePoll.

The survey asked 2,000 patients about their experience with a doctor's office and found that 73% of patients are likely to keep a "mental scorecard" of all the things they like and dislike about a new doctor's office. Surprisingly, doctors' offices are given, on average, four chances before a patient decides to find a new doctor.
