The Medicare reimbursement associated with diabetic shoes and inserts runs on the calendar year, so Kanter is still optimistic that patients who have been unable to receive their shoes and inserts thus far will ultimately receive them before year end.

"As the end of the year approaches, practices are undoubtedly going to be stressed in making sure all of their eligible diabetic patients are receiving the shoes and inserts that they need, and we'll be here doing whatever it takes to support them through that."
